

**Minutes of 269<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the NRC held from 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 to 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2017  
(Part 6)**

The 269<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), National Council for Teacher Education was held from 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 to 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2017 at NRC, NCTE, Jaipur.

The State Representatives of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Chandigarh did not attend the meeting.

With permission of the Chair, Shri Satish Gupta, Regional Director (I/C), NRC & Convener presented the Agenda before the Committee. Item-wise decisions taken on each agenda item are as under:

**Name of the College :- Shimla College of Education, Plot Number – 38,39 & 40, Street/ Road- NH 22, Village/Town/ City – Chamiana, Post Office – Sanjauli, Tehsil/Taluka- Shimla (rural), Town/ City- Shimla, District- Shimla, State- Himachal Pradesh, Pincode- 171006 (File Code NRCAPP- 7052) Course- M.ED  
(Note: Prof Y.K. Sharma was not present during the discussions in the case.)**

**Rejection**

The case of the institution was considered by the NRC in its 268<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Part - 2) and the Committee decided that SCN U/s 14/15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act 1993 be issued and the same was issued on 26.04.2017. The reply of this SCN was received by the office of the NRC on 27.04.2017 NRC considered the reply and found it unsatisfactory. NRC decided that the reply is not acceptable. Hence, the Committee decided that the application is rejected and recognition/permission is refused U/s 14/15(3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

In compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 28.04.2017 in W.P. No. 3683/2017 NRC considered the case of the petitioner in 269<sup>th</sup> meeting being held from 26<sup>th</sup> April 2017 to 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017

Shri R.D. Dhiman, Principal Secretary (Education) was present in the 266<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Part 2) dated 21 to 24 March, 2017 of the NRC as Representative, Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. On his advice a letter was sent to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh dated 24.03.2017 on which he constituted a committee to inspect Shimla College of Education. The Committee submitted its report on 07.04.2017. NRC considered the report and issued a SCN dated 26.04.2017. NRC considered the reply of this SCN submitted by the applicant institution as well as communication dated 20.04.2017 sent by the applicant institution. On the basis of this consideration, NRC made the following observations:

1. The institution has not submitted any authentic documents issued by the competent Govt. authorities to substantiate its claims made in the various paras of the reply dated 26.04.2017. Para- 6 of the reply dated 26.04.2017 of the institution reads "The college situated in khasra No. 38 and not in Khasra no. 8 and it cannot be in Khasra No. 8 as alleged. Khasra No. 8 is not in the name of Dr. R.K. Shandil which version of the Govt. Officials is incorrect....."  
The institution was given an opportunity to explain the differences in the Govt. official's versions and the claim of the institution in this regard by providing documentary evidences, duly verified by the Govt. but the Institution did not provide such evidences. A statement written by the institution which is totally different from the findings of the Govt. officials can not be relied upon in the absence of concrete and solid documentary evidences.

2. The allegations made against the competent Govt. officials in the form of “The Govt. officials have wrongly found .....” (para 5 of the reply dated 27.04.2017) are very serious. These have been made without any concrete and solid documentary evidences. These have been wrongly made to claim that the findings of the Govt. Officials were incorrect. Such an attempt does not speak well of the intentions of the institution and has been made to mislead the NRC.
3. The contents in Para 7 definitely go against the claim of the institution with regard to the ownership of the land and the building. The line to be quoted reads as “If, however after the adjudication of consolidation/settlement proceedings which involves discrepancy of huge portion of prime land, some changes effected with respect to built – up area or otherwise the same **shall be carried out after transferring and vesting the title of the built up area/land in the name of institution** immediately as per the Clause 8(4) (iii) of Regulations, 2014”. This statement clearly reveals that the built-up area/ land is not yet in the name of the Institution.
4. The decision of the NRC taken in its meeting held from 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2017 (Part 2) at S.No. 1 reads as “Hence, SCN be issued to the applicant institution to explain the anomaly whether the building is located on Khasra No. 8 or 38 (duly verified by the State Govt.) U/s 14/15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to submit the reply within 30 days from the date of issue of the SCN”. Compliance of the decision of the NRC which reads “**(duly verified by the State Govt.)**” has not been made by the institution. Latest documents showing the exact location of the building, duly verified by the Govt. have not been submitted by the institution.

On the basis of the above observations, NRC decided that the decision for Rejection taken in its 268<sup>th</sup> Meeting part 3<sup>rd</sup> dated 28.04.2017 at S.No. 24 stands the same.
