Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the subject cited above, institution has submitted an application in online mode on 28.12.2012 and physical application has been received in the office of NRC on 28.12.2012 for B.Ed. (Co.Ed.) Course in the proposed institution i.e. Sai Nath College, Plot No.- 1670, Village- Kundol, Post Office- Kundol, Tehsil/Taluka- Sadar, Dist.- Agra, Uttar Pradesh- 282003.

2. The said application has been processed by the NRC, NCTE as per provisions contained in the NCTE Regulation 2009. It is informed that on preliminary perusal of the documents submitted with your application viz a viz provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2009, your application is found deficient on the following points which are as under:-

- Originally notarized change of land use (CLU) certificate issued by SDM under section 143 of UP Land Act not submitted.
- The copy of approved building plan indicating name of institution, name of course, khasra No./Plot No. of land, total land area and earmarked built up area, size of multipurpose hall and class rooms etc for the proposed course is required to be submitted.
- The Plot no. 1668KA mentioned in the land document is not matching with application form, Affidavit of Rs.100/- and Building plan.
- The proposal of the college is situated at Plot no. 1670 as per application form, whereas the plot no. 1670 and 1668KA is mentioned in the land documents.
- The institution is required to submit an Affidavit of Rs.100/- stamp paper as per the format enclosed in support of information required as per clause 8(2), 8(3) and 8(7)(ii) of the NCTE Regulations 2009 & page 4 & 5 of the Online Application form.

3. You are advised to remove/make well of the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days failing which your application will be treated as rejected and closed. It may be noted by the institution it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.

4. Your reply/representation along with all necessary documents accompanied with an Affidavit in support of the reply of the above points must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Rules & Regulations.

5. Reply in piece meal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of Regulation 2009, hence once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application/processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever is the case.
