Sub: Application seeking grant of recognition for starting M.Ed. course to St. Paul College of Education Rohtak, Plot/Khasra No.- 51/14, Village-Para, Post Office-Rohtak, Tehsil/Taluka/Town/city-Rohtrak, District-Rohtak-124001, State-Haryana.

Ref:- As per the decision taken by NRC in its 210th meeting held from 28th to 29th January, 2013.

Sir/Madam,

The Society/Trust has submitted an application on 01.10.2011 and physical application has been received in the office of NRC on 18.10.2011 for M.Ed. course in the proposed institution, St. Paul's College of Education, Street-Tigaon Road, Near District Jail, Village & Post office-Neemka, Tehsil/Taluka-Faridabad, District-Faridabad-121004, Haryana.

A deficiency letter dated 15.05.2012 was issued to the institution. Since the institution did not submitted the reply of the same, the application of the institution was rejected as per the NRC decision taken in its 202nd meeting. Accordingly a rejection order dated 09.08.2012 was issued to the institution. Aggrieved with the decision of the NRC, NCTE the institution filed an Appeal before the Appellate Authority. The Appellate Authority remanded back the case of St. Paul College of Education, Rohtak, Haryana to the NRC, NCTE to reissue the deficiency letter and thereafter process the case as per regulations.

The matter was considered by the NRC, in its 210th meeting whereby the NRC decided the following:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time has been carefully considered by NRC.

The Committee discussed and considered the case in detail and following observations were made:

- As per the direction of the Appellate Authority, the case of the institution be processed.
- The institution may also may be asked if the institution is running any other course with no. of intake and NAAC accreditation result.

In view of the above decision of the NRC, the institution is required to submit a reply to the following points:

1. The online application was made on 01.10.2011 and the hard copy of the same is received on 18.10.2011. As such it cannot be ensured hard copy in triplicate of the online application is dispatched within 7 days of the submission of the online application. Hence proof of dispatch is required in compliance to the provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2009.
2. The institution has not submitted certified copy of the land documents. The institution is required to submit a certificate copy of the land documents issued by the competent authority under provision of clause 8(7) (i) of the NCTE Regulation, 2009.
3. The institution has submitted photocopy of building plan. The institution is require to submit building plan in blue print approved by the competent Government authority clearly showing

the name of the institution Khasara/plot no., total land area & built up area, multipurpose hall, different resource centre, class room, library etc.

4. *The building completion certified submitted by the institution do no show complete details as per required by the NCTE, the institution is required to submit a fresh building completion certificated as per the prescribed forma*
5. *The institution has not submitted the Fixed Deposit Receipt for Rs. 5.00 lakhs of Nationalized bank towards Endowment funds and Fixed Deposit Receipt for Rs. 3.00 lakhs of Nationalized bank towards Reserve fund under provision of clause 10(1) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.*
6. *The institution has not submitted notarized copy of change of land use certificate issued by the competent authority as per Regulation 2009. Hence the institution is required to submit notarized copy of change of land use certificate issued by the competent authority.*
7. *The institution is also required to clarify its status with reference to clause 8(3) & 8(4) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 which provides the following:-*
 - a. *An institution can apply for one basic unit only of an additional course or for an additional unit of the existing recognized course after completion of three academic sessions of the respective course, for which the institution shall submit application before the cutoff date prescribed for submission of applications in the year succeeding the completion of three academic sessions. Maximum intake capacity of an institution taking into consideration of all courses, alongwith additional intake, in any case, shall not exceed 300.*
 - b. *An institution shall be permitted to apply for new course of Master of Education and Master of Physical Education and enhancement of intake in-Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Physical Education, Master of Education and Master of Physical Education Programme, after it has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with at least a letter Grade B developed by NAAC.*

3. You are advised to remove /make good the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days. It may be noted by the institution that it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.


4. Your reply/representation along with all necessary documents must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.

5. The institution is also required to submit an Affidavit on Rs 100/- stamp paper as per format enclosed in support of information required as per clause 8(2), 8(3) and 8(7) (2) of NCTE Regulations, 2009 and Page 2,4 and 5 of the online application form.

6. Reply in piecemeal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of NCTE Regulations, 2009, hence, once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application /processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever been the case.
