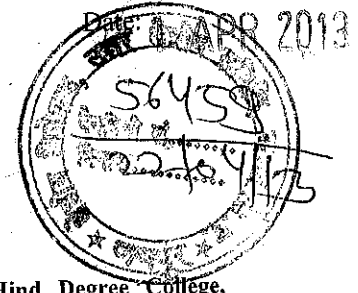

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the subject cited above, institution has submitted an application in online mode on 30.12.2012 and physical application has been received in the office of NRC on 31.12.2012 for B.Ed. course in the proposed institution by Hind Degree College, Plot/Khasara No.- 316, Street Number- Sidiki Road, Village- Nandanpur, Post Office- Nagal, Tehsil/Taluka- Deoband, Town/City- Deoband, District- Saharanpur, Pin Code- 247001, State- Uttar Pradesh. The said application has been processed by the NRC, NCTE as per provisions contained in the NCTE Regulation 2009. It is informed that on preliminary perusal of the documents submitted with your application viz a viz provisions of the NCTE Regulation, 2009, your application is found deficient on the following points which are as under:-

1. Original FDRs of Rs. Five Lakh and Three Lakh of nationalized bank towards Endowment fund and Reserved Fund respectively has not submitted.
 2. The institution has not submitted certified copy of registered land document.
 3. The institution has not submitted approved building plan in original. The original building plan approved by competent authority indicating name of Institution, name of the course, Khasra No./Plot No. of land, total land area & built up area, size of multipurpose hall, class rooms, library, different resource centre etc as per NCTE norms for the proposed course is required to be submitted.
 4. Date of registration of land documents and name of the office of registration is not mentioned in the Affidavit.
 5. Notarized copy of change of land use certificate issued under clause 143 of UP land Act by the competent authority has not submitted.
 6. The specific information of land/building, demarcated area as required in clause 8(7)(i) and information required under clause 8(2) 8(3) of NCTE Regulations 2009 and information related to resolution of the society for opening the said course not for profit etc. has not given by the institution, hence, the same is required from the institution in the affidavit (format of the affidavit is enclosed herewith).
2. You are advised to remove/make good of the above deficiencies within a period of 60 days failing which your application will be treated as rejected and closed. It may be noted by the institution it is the sole responsibility of the institution to ensure proper compliance of all the essential documents as per provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations.
3. Your reply/representation alongwith all necessary documents accompanied with an Affidavit in support of the reply of the above points must be submitted within 60 days of issue of this letter, failing which appropriate action will be taken as per provisions of the NCTE Rules & Regulations.
4. Reply in piece meal will not be accepted. Since application has been processed as per clause 6 of Regulation 2009, hence once the application is duly processed by this office, the claim for refund of application/processing fee cannot be made at any stage of application, whatsoever be the case.
