Subject: - Letter of intent prior to grant of recognition/Permission for D.El.Ed. course under Clause 7(9) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Production) Regulation, 2009, reg.

Sir/Madam,

In terms of section 14/15 of the NCE Act, 1993 your Institution had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting D.El.Ed. course in the proposed institution i.e. Smt Shanti Devi Educational Institute, Plot/Khasara No-121, Plot No. - 121, Street Number- Nr NH11, Vill-Laramada, Post Office- Shahara, Teh/Taluk- Agra Sadar, Town/City- Agra, Dist- Agra, State-UP, Pin-283105.

2. The NRC, NCTE on the basis of the scrutiny of the documents submitted by the institution, input received from the Visiting Team Report and videography in its 223rd meeting held on 17th to 19th January, 2014 decided that the above institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library and laboratory as prescribed in the norms and standards and that it fulfils all such other conditions relating to infrastructural and instructional facilities required for proper functioning of the institution for a teacher education course. Therefore, the NRC, decided to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition for D.El.Ed. course under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulation to the Institution.

3. As per provision of clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, the process of appointment of qualified staff as per policy of State Government or University Grant Commission or University may be initiated by the institution and affiliating body will provide all assistance to the institution to ensure that the staff or faculty is appointed as per National Council for Teacher Education norms within two months. The institution shall submit the list of faculty, as approved by the affiliating body, to the Regional Committee.

4. In this regard as per decision taken by NRC in its 199th meeting, it is clarified that the above implies that where there exists a provision of nomination of experts for the Selection Committee by the affiliating university, the same be adhered to. In the absence of such a provision in the Act/Statutes of the affiliating university, the institution shall select faculty members by employing a transparent, objective and judicious process and shall get the list of selected teachers approved by the affiliating university. This approved list, along with details of educational qualifications and teaching experience, shall be submitted by the institution to the Regional Committee.

5. Before grant of formal recognition under Regulation 7(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2009 is considered, the institution shall make appointment of qualified faculty/staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 as per the norms & standards envisaged therein and submit the following documents:-

- The institution shall submit particulars of the staff duly approved by the University/affiliating body as per the prescribed format available in the NRC, NCTE website.
- Advertisement in leading newspapers.
- Letter of University/ Affiliating Body, nominating experts/representative for the Selection Committee.
- Recommendations of the Selection Committee for appointment of teaching & non-teaching staff as per the norms of the affiliating body.
- An affidavit on Rs. 100/-stamp paper to the effect that the institution has selected staff as per NCTE/State/University norms.(format Enclosed)
- Educational & professional qualification certificates of all teaching staff showing their eligibility for appointment as per the NCTE norms and experience certificate of the principal /HOD.
- Downloaded copies of the website of the institution with the hyperlink of the same as per provisions of 7(10) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

The institution shall convert the Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into a Joint Account and furnish the evidence / documents in this regard to NRC. An authorisation letter from the Regional Director, NRC, NCTE authorising the institution to convert the FDR into joint account is enclosed. The following FDRs in original are returned herewith.
