**ORDER**

The institution namely N.I.M.T.Mahila B.Ed. College, SP-3-1, RIICO Industrial Area, Keswara, Kotputli, Jaipur, Rajasthan was granted recognition for various teacher training courses as below :-

AND WHEREAS, many complaints was received against the institution and inspection under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 was conducted on 23.11.2007 and the matter was considered by the NRC in its 124<sup>th</sup> meeting (1<sup>st</sup> sitting) held on 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>, December 2007 whereby the Committee noted that the following deficiencies exists vis-à-vis NCTE Norms :-

1. The institution has no fixed classrooms for teaching all the teacher education courses.
2. The classrooms were classified temporarily.
3. The building is still under construction.
4. Furniture is not provided in some of the rooms.
5. The staff room and classroom were full with furniture at the time of inspection, which shows that no classes were held.
6. Principal and staff are not qualified as per NCTE Norms.
7. The Attendance Register of the staff was not shown to the Visiting Team.
8. The Books related to teacher education are not provided in the library.
9. Journals are not subscribed at all.

AND WHEREAS NRC directed that an opportunity be given to the institution to make a written representation within 30 days from the date of issue of the letter before withdrawal of recognition as per provisions contained under Section 17 of the NCTE Act on account of deficiencies as mentioned above and therefore, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.02.2008.

AND WHEREAS the matter was again considered by the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) in its 127<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2008 and having taken into consideration all the relevant facts of the case, it was decided to withdraw recognition for conducting B.Ed. (Secondary), ETT / STC (Elementary) and NTT (Pre Primary) courses from the end of the academic session i.e. 2007-2008.

NOW therefore, recognition to N.I.M.T. Mahila B.Ed. College, SP-3-1, RICO Industrial Area, Keswana, Kotputli, Jaipur, Rajasthan for the B.Ed. (Secondary), ETT / STC (Elementary) and NTT (Pre Primary) courses in terms of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 is hereby withdrawn from the ~~new~~ academic session 2007-2008 on the following grounds :- *end of the world*

1. The institution has no fixed classrooms for teaching all the teacher education courses.
2. The classrooms were classified temporarily.
3. The building is still under construction.
4. Furniture is not provided in some of the rooms.
5. The staff room and classroom were full with furniture at the time of inspection, which shows that no classes were held.
6. Principal and staff are not qualified as per NCTE Norms.
7. The Attendance Register of the staff was not shown to the Visiting Team.
8. The Books related to teacher education are not provided in the library.
9. Journals are not subscribed at all.

Affiliating Body / State Govt. are advised not to admit / allot any student in B.Ed. (Secondary), ETT / STC (Elementary) and NTT (Pre Primary) courses in the said institute. In accordance to the Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such courses or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi - 110002 against this order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
