Refusal Order

123 JAN 2018

The institution had applied in 2012 for grant of recognition for D.E.C.Ed Course. The application was rejected and returned to the institution in view of the State Government negative recommendation.

The institution filed W.P. No. 2691/2016 in the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan and the Hon'ble Court passed an order dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2016. The operative part of the Order is as under:

*"In the event of the petitioner making a representation/ application for recognition of BSTC Course for academic Year 2016-17, it be disposed of by a reasoned order strictly in accordance with law without being influenced in any manner whatsoever by the liberty granted by this court to move such an application. The consideration shall be confined to the question of the application for recognition being compliant with the Regulations of 2014 in all aspects."*

And, Whereas, the application was processed and lastly the VTR / Reply to Letter of Intent was to be considered by the NRC.

And, Whereas, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 264<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Part -5) held from 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2017 and the Committee decided as under: -

*The matter regarding applications received from the Teacher Education Institutes in the State of Rajasthan along with legal advice obtained, was considered by NRC and it was decided as under: -*

- *In cases where the institutions have submitted the applications by offline mode along with Court orders and where no processing has been initiated by NRC, all such applications be returned to the institutions along with all documents as they have not submitted the applications as per Clause 5, of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- *In cases where the applications were resubmitted along with Court orders through offline mode and processed, the NRC decided that in all such cases, show cause notice be issued to the institution before refusing recognition on the following points:*
  1. *As per clause 5, Regulations, 2014, an institution desirous of running a Teacher Education Programme shall submit the application online electronically along with processing Fees and relevant documents.*
  2. *Application shall be submitted along with No Objection Certificate issued by the concerned affiliating body.*
  3. *The institution has not submitted any proofovidence of its being a composite institution as required under Rule 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*

Accordingly, Show cause notice was issued to the institution.

And whereas, the case of the institution was considered by NRC in its 278<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and the Committee decided as under:

*NRC observed that the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jaipur dated 18.04.2016 reads as follows:-*

"W.P. disposed as withdrawn with the liberty to move an application before NRC, for recognition and the same is to be decided by Reasoned & speaking order by NRC strictly in accordance with Regulation, 2014".

The Committee further noted the judgement given in CWP No. 10960/2016 vide order dated 26.04.2017, by the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jaipur specifically mentioning that "according to the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which came into force after the judgment given by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of State of Maharashtra Vs. Sant Dnyaneshwar Shikshan Shahstra Mahavidyalaya, an applicant desirous of establishing a teacher training institute could move an application for recognition of its Teacher Training Course only subsequent to the grant of NOC. Applications pending when the Regulations, 2014 came into force were not to be resubmitted but considered only in terms of the Regulations, 2014. Thus to be valid and competent such pending applications were to be buttressed by the requisite NOC from the affiliating body with reference to Regulation 5(3) of the said regulations.

NRC considered the case and observed that SCN was issued to the institution by the NRC. The reply of the SCN was considered by the NRC and the Committee decided that the recognition be refused primarily on the following grounds while other requirements under NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended from time to time) viz. Land, Building, CLU etc. have not been taken into consideration: -

- The Petitioner Society has not submitted the application online electronically along with processing fees and relevant documents as per clause 5 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- No Objection Certificate issued by the concerned affiliating body has not been submitted by the petitioner Society alongwith the application.
- The institution has not submitted any proof/evidence of its being a composite institution as required under Clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby rejects the application of the institution i.e. **Manasvi Teacher Training College, Plot No. 123, Village-Gopalpura, P.O.-Kanore, Tehsil-Vallabha Nagar, Distt. Udaipur, Rajasthan, Pin Code-313604.** for D.E.C.Ed. course and recognition/ permission is refused on the grounds above mentioned above.

If the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the online mode available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on the NCTE website.
